

Terms and Conditions for the Free 30-Day Trial for the Immersive Learning Factory Companion Animal and Equine OSCE VR Programme.

1. Introduction

These Terms and Conditions govern the use of the free 30-day trial of [VR Programme Name] ("the Programme") offered by Immersive Learning Factory ("we", "us", or "our") via our website. By accessing or using the Programme, you agree to be bound by these Terms and Conditions. If you do not agree with any part of these terms, you must not use the Programme.

2. Eligibility

The free trial is available exclusively to non-UK based colleges and educational institutions ("Institutions"). By using the Programme, you represent and warrant that you are an authorized representative of such an Institution and that your Institution does not operate within the United Kingdom.

3. Trial Period

The free trial period lasts for 30 days from the date of activation ("Trial Period"). Upon expiration of the Trial Period, access to the Programme will be automatically disabled unless you purchase a subscription. Only one trial period is available per Institution, including all departments and affiliated entities.

4. Use of the Programme

During the Trial Period, you are granted a limited, non-exclusive, non-transferable license to use the Programme for evaluation purposes only. Any use beyond evaluation, including but not limited to commercial use, is strictly prohibited.

4.1 Hardware Requirements

To access and use the Programme during the Trial Period, your Institution must possess its own virtual reality (VR) headset. The Programme is compatible only with Oculus and Pico VR headsets. We do not supply VR headsets, and it is the sole responsibility of your



Institution to ensure the availability and compatibility of the required hardware. Failure to have compatible VR headsets will limit the ability to use the Programme effectively, for which we shall not be held liable.

5. Limitations of Liability

We provide the Programme on an "as is" and "as available" basis. We do not make any representations or warranties, express or implied, regarding the Programme's performance or suitability for any particular purpose. To the fullest extent permitted by law, we shall not be liable for any direct, indirect, incidental, special, consequential, or punitive damages resulting from your access to or use of the Programme.

6. Restrictions

You may not:

Distribute, sell, lease, rent, or otherwise provide access to the Programme to any third party;

Modify, disassemble, decompile, or reverse engineer the Programme;

Use the Programme in a way that could harm us or any third party;

Use the Programme for any illegal or unauthorized purpose.
